# Suggested Plein Air Workshop Supply List 

## Portable Easel \& Palette:

Two options I can suggest are the French Easel or the Pochade Box. Both come with an easel.

## Canvas boards:

$8 \times 10 \mathrm{~s}, 9 \times 12 \mathrm{~s}, 11 \times 14 \mathrm{~s}$ and $12 \times 16 \mathrm{~s}$

## Colors:

Titanium White, Permanent Yellow, Lemon Yellow, Naples Yellow, Yellow Ochre, Permanent Rose, Permanent or Cad Red, Ultramarine Blue, Cobalt Blue, Cerulean Blue, and occasionally, Viridian Green. I tend to buy Winsor \& Newton and Utrecht paints most.

## Brushes:

Any good quality brush will do. I most commonly use Robert Simmons brushes.
flats and/or bright bristle, sizes 2-8 for smaller work, larger sizes as suits your needs.

## Misc:

A jar of odorless Mineral Spirits, paper towels and a plastic grocery bag for trash, A palette knife for cleaning palette and painting needs.

Hat, water bottle, sunscreen, bug repellent and a snack/lunch. We will not be stopping for Lunch together, but you will have opportunities to eat as you wish.
